

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


Current State of High Hazard Safety Mgmt

Safety Data often goes into a "black hole"

Safety teams have little insight into what is getting done – and who isn't doing what they're supposed to doing.

- Paper-heavy processes to collect field safety data are time consuming and inefficient
- Spreadsheets for managing certification and training data become unwieldy and difficult to extract good data
- "Disconnected" point solutions creates confusion and challenges, especially for field level users
- Safety binders with printed materials, safety documents, or certificate data get lost onsite or are simply not available when someone needs them

Reduce Your Exposure to Costly Fines, Keep Workforce Safe, and Cut Your Safety Admin Time



High Quality Training Makes a Difference


- Meets compliance and certification requirements

Limitations of excel and sign-in sheets

- Not easily maintained/time consuming
- Challenging to quickly extract pertinent data
- Not being able to run reports easily
- No "clean" way to share proof of training
- Lack of automate reminders/notifications

Toolbox Talks for a Digital World



- Paperless toolbox talks tracked in the matter of minutes
- Ensuring proof of training for all meeting attendees is critical from a compliance standpoint
- Putting the ownership in the hands of the field leads
- Automatic reminders, notifications, alerts and shareable PDF reports
- Source reputable content from online providers



Job Planning with a Purpose

- Job Planning = Job Hazard Analysis, Pre-Task Planning, Job Safety Analysis, etc.
- Key components include safety and health consideration checklists, permits required checklist, tools and equipment required checklist.
- The three column approach to job planning
- Incorporating a risk assessment matrix for better insight and analytics
- An informed, educated, and aware field staff will yield positive results from an incident perspective





Incident Management made Seamless

- Define critical steps to your incident management workflow
- Leverage data collected in the incident management process to populate OSHA Logs
- KPIs such as DART and TRIR provide at a glance metrics
- Consider electronic logging of OSHA reportables for seamless yearly submissions to OSHA





Turning Field Data into KPIs That Matter

- Analytics and metrics lead to safer jobsites
- Project scorecards determine project health
- Quickly assess all data being collected to analyze trends, key performance indicators, and leading/lagging indicators





Preparing for Implementation

1. Have import data ready

- Projects/locations, users (employees),
 certificate history
- Good data in, good data out
- Excel format will always be best

2. Devices in the field?

- Determine if you field team needs mobile devices or if the devices they have will work
- Consider what platforms the software is available on

3. Identify Super Admins

• Who will be responsible for "admining" the software (add users, add projects, maintain core data)

4. Admin & Field Training

- •90%+ of software rollouts are fully adopted when the field users are trained effectively
- •Consider whether you will ask the software provider to train the team or will you take the "train the trainer" approach




Integration Saves Time & Money

Benefits of Integration

- Gives an "all-in-one" experience
- Reduction of rework or double entry
- Automated data flow to/from linked software

Questions to Ask

- Does the software have an open API?
- Can the software connect to an open API?
- Does the software charge for integration setup?
- How frequently does the integration run?
