In 2020 at the Rocky Mountain winter meeting in Vail, Colorado the chapter board officially voted to rename the Scholarship program to the **Jerry Simms Scholarship** Program.

Who was Jerry? Jerry received ISRI's Lifetime Achievement in 2019 for his decades of dedication and leadership within the industry. It was Jerry who inspired and led ISRI's efforts to reform Superfund that resulted in passage of the Superfund Recycling Equity Act (SREA) in 1999. His letter to the ISRI leadership in the early 90s, calling for the rallying of ISRI members at the grassroots level and the leveraging of their political power to effect change that spurred ISRI's efforts on this critical issue. Jerry helped mobilize the industry and build the political structure that remains today at ISRI. According to Jerry, "when working in concert, ISRI and our members can achieve any successes we need in the battles that confront us, be they legislative, regulatory, or public perception."
