



Accident Do's and Don'ts

The following "do's and don'ts" should serve as reminders about driving safely and avoiding the most common types of accidents.

DO's of Safe Driving	DON'Ts of Safe Driving
Observe the speed limit and wear your seat	Don't drive while fatigued or while taking
belt.	medications that might impair your
	driving.
Signal your intentions far in advance.	Don't follow the vehicle ahead too closely.
Learn to recognize hazards and how to	Don't fail to report all safety problems and
avoid them.	concerns.
Regularly scan your mirrors before changing	Don't assume others see you particularly
speed or direction.	at night.
Always perform thorough pre-trip and post-	Don't drive if safety related equipment is
trip inspections.	not in proper operating condition,
	especially lights, brakes, and tires.
Test, inspect, and adjust your brakes	Don't leave your vehicle unsecured, shut
frequently.	off engine, and set parking brake.
Assume other drivers make errors.	Don't take risk.

If you are involved in an accident, don't panic. Take steps to prevent other accidents, report the accident immediately and follow your company accident reporting procedures.
