NEW EMPLOYEE ORIENTATION

Make the time to **spend** some time with **every** new employee, *including temps*, and cover **at least** the following issues:

If I get hurt, who do I tell and when?
What PPE is required to do my job safely? Why? How do I wear it?
Where do I go in case of fire, tornado, and other emergencies?
Where is the First Aid Kit in my work area?
Where are the MSDS sheets?
What is Lockout/Tagout? Can I do it?
Why are machine guards in place? Do I ever take them off?
Can I get on a forklift today? What training do I need to operate equipment?
Where is the eyewash station?
Are there any restricted areas where I cannot go? What are the hazards there?
Where are the traffic areas?
What hazards are there near my work area?
Where are the high hazard areas?
How close can I stand to mobile equipment?
Are there any confined spaces? Can I go in them?
Where are the fire extinguishers in my work area?
Are there trains near my work area?
How does what I do fit into the overall operation?
How do I report a near miss?
Can I get fired for doing something that's not safe?

Your operation may have other items you need to discuss with your new employees. Make the time to do this *before* they start work. Don't rely on a temp agency to properly train your workers on the processes and hazards of your operation. Document this process. Make no exceptions.
