



Seven Keys to City Driving

- 1. Understand the traffic waves Prior knowledge of peak travel times and traffic patterns will save you time and fuel.
- 2. Be Predictable Sudden movements cause accidents. Steady, predictable movements give other motorist a chance to react (turn signals).
- 3. Expect the unexpected Expect delays, and getting cut off by other motorist.
- 4. Know the height of your truck Select routes to eliminate the risk of bridge strikes.
- 5. Brake for pedestrians 85% of pedestrian accidents occurs in cities.
- 6. Pre plan your route Plan your route and stops at the time of dispatch.
- 7. Compensate your turns for busy narrow streets Ensure your mirrors are properly adjusted, and exercise care when making turns.
