



Top 10 CSA Violations

Of the top ten Compliance Safety Accountability (CSA) violations, seven could be prevented with one simple step, a thorough driver pre-trip inspection. Inspecting the truck before driving is the law, and yet 70% of the CSA violations are truck related.
