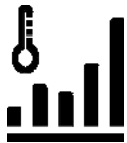


# The Trump administration has warned the EOP to prepare for executive orders

## EOs to expect in the coming weeks

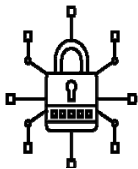


### Climate change

**Goal:** Bolster American energy independence

**What it will do:**

- 1) Instruct the Environmental Protection Agency to rewrite the 2015 regulation that limits greenhouse-gas emissions from existing electric utilities
- 2) Instruct the Interior Department's Bureau of Land Management (BLM) to lift a moratorium on federal coal leasing



### Cybersecurity

**Goal:** Assess current cyber vulnerabilities and create a plan to improve cyber infrastructure

**What it will do:**

- 1) Review cyber vulnerabilities
- 2) Review cyber adversaries
- 3) Review US cyber capabilities
- 4) Report on private sector infrastructure incentives

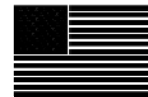


### Trade review

**Goal:** Review all trade deals

**What it will do:**

- 1) While largely symbolic, the order will examine the 14 agreements that are in place including two regional deals and 12 bilateral ones
- 2) Review the effect of the internet and other technological advancements in production on agreements



### Procurement process review

**Goal:** Review the US procurement provisions of trade deals

**What it will do:**

- 1) Push Trump's initiative to buy and hire American
- 2) Renegotiate the procurement provisions of trade deals that allow foreign companies to bid on US government contracts
