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Being in compliance with this self-audit checklist does not mean that a motor carrier or an individual driver is exempt from monetary fines and penalties. The purpose of this audit is to identify opportunities where management can improve a motor carrier's overall safety performance and safety management controls.





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Checklist framework comprised of six components:

- 1) General Responsibilities: Minimum level of financial responsibilities, and general requirements.
- 2) Driver Responsibilities: Controlled substances / alcohol, commercial driver's license, and driver qualification.
- 3) Operational Responsibilities: Driving of commercial motor vehicles, and hours-of-service.

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Checklist Framework Continued:

- 4) Vehicle Responsibilities: Parts and accessories, inspection, repair and maintenance.
- 5) Hazmat Responsibilities (if applicable): Transportation of hazardous materials, driving and parking rules (packaging, loading, unloading, and etc.).
- 6) Crash Responsibilities: Recordable accident rate for the previous 12 months. (Inadequate control: urban carriers > than 1.7, all other carriers > than 1.5).





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- •We recommend that you perform the audit in portions, over a two three day period.
- We recommend that you conduct this self-audit annually.
- We recommend that you seek the assistance of a safety consultant or legal counsel if you need assistance.
